Good Standing Certificate will ONLY be issued by PCP local Chapters

Ensure your registration to the local PCP Chapter of your choice by updating your Membership Status

Good Standing Certificate will be issued for free by your local Chapter if for Philhealth purposes. Otherwise, some form of payment will be required.

PCP releases members' RFIDs

Provincial PCP Chapters can get their RFIDs from Chapter Presidents now. NCR Chapter RFIDs ready by Sept. 15

RFIDs cannot be issued without updating your Membership Status. Log on to pcp.org.ph and fill up completely the PCP Membership Update Form. Deadline is September 30, 2015.

RFIDs is a must for: attendance to local PCP Chapter's meetings, preregistration to conventions, attendance to CMEs, annual convention, PCP business meeting, etc.

RFIDs valid only for 5 years, thereafter, renewal must be done on member's birth month.

For members who submitted blurred photos, re-submit a high-resolution copy or RFIDs cannot be printed.

- 11. Special Privilege for Organizing Committee Members: 10 rooms are reserved for them in a hotel (twin sharing) near the convention venue; priority is given to members with critical functions during the actual convention; must do their own arrangement and schedules; list of room and date assignments must be submitted to the PCP secretariat; rooms that will not be utilized will be offered to other delegates.
- 12. Beginning 2016, the Host Chapter of the Annual Convention will be rotated to the eight (8) NCR PCP Chapters. The host chapter receives P200, 000.
- 13. Beginning 2016, the Host Chapter of the Midyear Convention gets 50% share of the NET income of the convention (registration fees, exhibits, royalties, etc.) while the National PCP gets the rest of the 50%.
